Classroom Goals 2006-2007

OBJECTIVE: Students are to be in their assigned seats (or assigned spot for marching band) with their instruments every day for the duration of the class period.

1. Objective will be clearly stated and will be reiterated as needed.
2. Students will keep instruments and other equipment out and ready until dismissed by the director.
3. Students will leave the band hall in an organized manner.

OBJECTIVE: Students will participate actively every day throughout the class period.

1. Lessons will be planned and structured to include all students.
2. When necessary, classes will be divided into sections so all are learning and receiving as much individual attention as possible.
3. When necessary, students not directly involved in instruction will have individual assignments or group work with others not directly involved.
4. Students without equipment will be included in ALL the same instruction as the other students on the same instruments.

OBJECTIVE: Students will have consistent, quality instruction that adheres to the expectations of the John Horn High School campus and M.I.S.D.

1. The class lesson plans, selections of music and other materials will be done by The John Horn H. S. Director within the guidelines of the curriculum adopted by M.I.S.D. Assistant Directors or Middle School Directors who have been given the responsibility of a performing group at John Horn High School will select materials for that group with the approval of the Head Director.
2. Directors from other schools assisting at John Horn High School will have clear instructions on the lesson plans they are to follow and the expectations of the John Horn H.S. director.
3. Directors from other schools assisting at John Horn High School will be expected to follow the discipline plan consistently as set forth, so disruptions are kept to a minimum and quality instruction can occur.
