Read the "to bring" list on the back of this page so that you are prepared. I must know if you will not be at any of the summer band rehearsals so that I can make arrangements for your absence. We will have alternates for the drill. You do not want to be an alternate and the way to assure this is to be at summer band. What this means is that if you have an unexcused absence you could be replaced with an alternate. We need everyone to be in attendance of all rehearsals. If you have planned vacations or attending church or music camps please call me immediately and tell me what days you will miss and why.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO BRING:

- Wear light clothing NO SANDALS Tennis shoes and socks required
- Bring and wear sun screen
- Everyone wears a hat- even if you have more hair than Mr. B
- Sunglasses are great
- You must have your own water jug on the practice field at all times- ALL WATER BREAKS ARE TAKEN OUTSIDE. Please have water in your water jug- NOT A CARBONATED DRINK!!!
- Prepare for the heat by eating a good breakfast and drinking lots of fluids the night before.
- Lunch breaks can be taken away or eaten in the Fine Arts Hallway. NO FOOD OR DRINK, EVEN WATER, IN THE BAND ROOM
- Do Not Miss Rehearsal

It would be a smart thing to get out and take some morning walks to get yourself acclimated to the heat before band camp. You can't learn drill from the sidelines or sitting inside from being sick. Take the proper precautions and do not take the heat lightly.

Enclosed in this letter is a Band Supply List. If your student has certain items, you do not have to order them again. **Items that everyone must purchase are the show shirt and uniform cleaning.** If you need new shoes and gloves, we will have a size run of shoes and gloves to try on during band camp. We will be wearing our collared red shirts and **khaki shorts** to the first 2 or 3 games this year, so you may start to look for those early.

Also enclosed is a **Parent Volunteer list** for you to fill out and return to us so we can call you if we need your help. If you are available for our band camp outdoor rehearsals, we would like to have some parent volunteers help this year with water breaks. We will purchase a nice shade canopy and a couple of chairs for your comfort. Please e-mail or call me if you will be available for this honor.
