

Do I have to know anything about music to join

band? Most students who start band have little or no prior musical training. We start them from "scratch" in all phases. Those students with former training will find it an aid in their advancement.

What does the band director look for in helping me select an instrument? We look for a good attitude, a desire to be in the Band, and a willingness to work and to have fun! We also look at teeth and mouth formation, finger coordination and the Band's instrumentation needs.

How do I get an instrument? At band night, we will give you all the information you will need to purchase an instrument from a local music dealer. Most parents rent an instrument with an option to buy at a later date.

Are used instruments acceptable in the Band? Some are. If you wish to purchase or otherwise obtain a used instrument for your child, please let us help you evaluate it before you invest. An inferior quality instrument will only handicap your child and could possibly cost you more in repairs than the instrument is worth.

Are there any school instruments available? Some of the large and more expensive instruments are provided by the school such as Tubas, Bassoons, Oboes, Baritones, and French Horns. These instruments are owned by Mesquite ISD and are available for use. Students that play these instruments are required to purchase mouthpieces, reeds, and care kits.
